LOCAL ARCHAEOLOGIST GIVES LECTURE ON PUBLIC ARCHAEOLOGY PROJECT IN NEW SMYRNA

April 19, 2018, New Smyrna Beach, Fla.—Rebecca Harris, Executive Director and Founder of Smyrnéa Archaeological Research Institute (SARI) will be giving a lecture at the New Smyrna Beach Regional Library on Thursday, May 17th at 2:00pm. Harris, a Registered Professional Archaeologist since 2001, will be discussing the Westside Archaeology Project which SARI began in February as their inaugural research program. Learn about the value and role of archaeological research in providing a more equitable interpretation of the recent past. Harris will also provide an overview of upcoming research projects including how SARI plans to use 3D scanning technology and photogrammetry to investigate building methods and materials from the Smyrnéa colony.
